Presentation of Cape Coral's downtown vision plan to be broadcast

Cape Coral residents who want to see and hear about plans for downtown's future but who can't get to City Hall on Tuesday, Nov. 16, could still follow it on Comcast or online.

The presentation by Zyscovich Architects will be broadcast on Comcast channel 98 and online on the City's web page <u>www.capecoral.net</u>, according to Helen Ramey of the Community Redevelopment Agency, which hired the firm to produce the plan.

"Cape Coral is a relatively young city with great potential. This team effort has strived to identify a realistic vision that will foster the cooperation of those interested in the physical and economic development of South Cape." says Bernard Zyscovich, Managing Principal of Zyscovich Architects. "The vision is based upon history and the unique aspects of the area, as well as demographic and economic trends."

The presentation, which is part of the CRA board of directors' monthly meeting, begins at 5:30 p.m. in the City Council chambers at the City Hall, 1015 Cultural Park Blvd.

Zyscovich has produced an 85-page vision plan for the CRA's district. The plan, if adopted, will guide growth and development along and around Cape Coral Parkway for the next 20 years.
